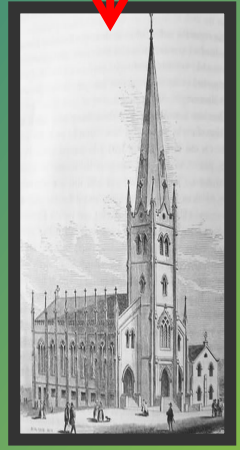

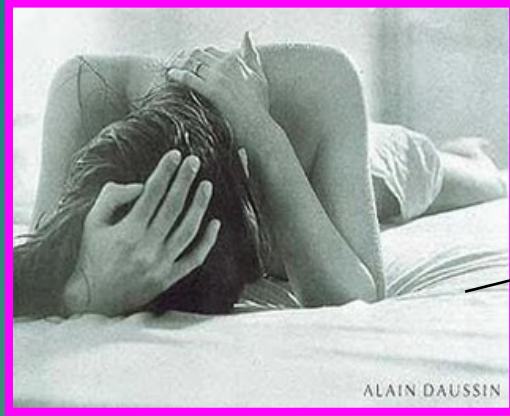


TRY TO FIND THE CORRECT ANSWERS FOR THE QUESTIONS ABOUT "YESTERDAY":
